





- Established in 2005 by a group of wheat growers, plant scientists, and public and private breeders
- Accelerate wheat improvement
- Produced the reference sequence of bread wheat (RefSeq) in 2017
- Latest version of assembly and annotation is IWGSC RefSeq v2.1

- Paradigm shift in agricultural research& production




